The eight hectare Polish Hill vineyard (ACO certified organic) is planted at 460 metres altitude and just five kilometres from Springvale. The low fertility soils of this hard rock site are composed of silt and shallow shales over a thin crust of clay and gravel. The vines have to work harder than those at Springvale and so produce small, thick skinned berries with bunches weighing just 100 grams.

THE WINE

A spectacular vintage with layer upon layer of powerful lime juice aromatics against a backdrop of enticing florals. The palate is intense with lime pith flavors, weight, power and a crisp, ultra-dry finish that lingers. It has the structure and intensity of flavor to become one of the great vintages.

THE WINEMAKER

Considered by many to be the undisputed ‘Monarch’ of Clare Valley Riesling, Jeffrey Grosset has been producing wine in the region for four decades. His winery is located in the historic township of Auburn about 100 km north of Adelaide. Working with four estate-owned ACO certified organic vineyards, Jeffrey and his team consistently create pure expressions of variety and place. All fruit is handpicked and hand pruned, and only free run juice is used to create his riesling. Annual production is capped at 11,000 cases of which only 25 percent is exported, but Grosset has cemented his winery as a benchmark in its class and continually receives significant international praise.
